



# Unnetie Digitisation Project

## Cut 'n' Play - Matching Pairs Game

### Overview

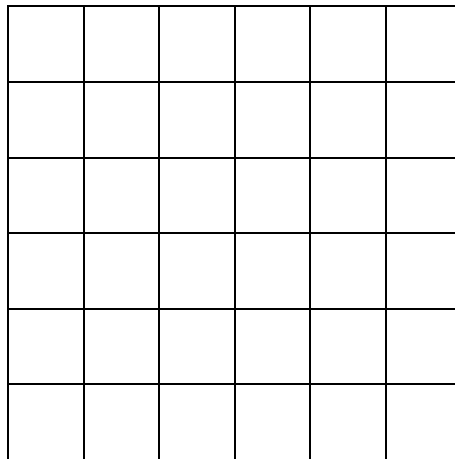
In this file you will find all the ingredients to play the Unnetie matching pairs game. It is a fun game for people of all ages that will test your memory skills.

### What you will need

A printer  
Some card or paper (9 sheets)  
Scissors  
Clock or a stopwatch (optional)

### Getting Started

Step 1 - Print out this document onto paper or card (recommended)  
Step 2 - Cut round the dotted edges of the pieces.  
Step 3 - Shuffle the cards but do not look at the cards.  
Step 4 - layout the pieces (blank side facing up) in a 6 x 6 grid like the picture below



### Rules

The aim of the game is to find all the matching paired images in the grid. You can do this against the clock or not. The game is finished when all the pictures have been matched and are facing upwards.

### How to Play

Step 1 - Start the clock (optional)  
Step 2 - Turnover any card from the grid  
Step 3 - Turnover a second card from the grid. If that card is the matching card with an identical picture then lay both cards, with the picture facing upwards, back on the grid. You have found that matching pair.  
Step 4 - If the second card does not match the first card then turn both cards back over so that the blank side is facing up again. You did not find a matching pair.  
Step 5 - Repeat step 2 - 4 until all 36 cards have been turned over and are facing upwards.  
Step 6 - Stop the clock (optional)
